Saints This Week

January 14—Two Brothers, Cyril (826-869) and Methodius (815-884)

These two brothers were very talented and worked hard to learn difficult foreign languages. They both had important work that they left in order to have more time to pray. They brought the Christian faith to people in southern Russia called the Khazars, first learning their language. Then they traveled to Moravia where they used their gift with language to learn Slavonic and even to design an alphabet which is still in use today. Together they translated the Bible for the many people they met.

January 17—Seven Friends

Seven men who lived in Florence, Italy decided to devote themselves to prayer and a simple life. Many people followed their example. The seven friends when they died were buried in one tomb.

New Testament

THE WALK TO EMMAUS

Luke 24: 13-35

We often call Jesus's Last Supper with his disciples the First Eucharist. We might call the simple meal that Jesus had in the village of Emmaus a Second Eucharist. In the First Eucharist Jesus had not yet suffered and died. In the meal at Emmaus Jesus was already risen. He first found two people walking along on a road. They were talking about the events in Jerusalem—of course the Crucifixion and Resurrection. Jesus wanted them to tell him more. After they told what they knew, he opened their hearts to the many times these events had been predicted by the prophets. They invited Jesus to stay and eat with them. When he took the bread and blessed it, suddenly he disappeared. Only then did they recognize that they had seen Jesus. We also know Jesus in the breaking of the bread.
