SAINTS THIS WEEK

January 20—Saint Fabian (died around 220)

Saint Fabian was one of the few popes who had never been a priest. He was one of the first martyrs when Decius was emperor of Rome. At that time Christians were killed if they refused to sacrifice to idols.

January 25—The Conversion of Saint Paul

You can read all about Saint Paul's conversion in the 9th chapter of Acts. Paul was the Roman name of Saul. Paul was strongly against anyone who tried to teach the Jesus was Lord and that He had risen from the dead. Paul felt so strongly about opposing the new faith that he even got permission from the Temple rulers to arrest Christians in Damascus. It was on the road to Damascus that he first heard the voice of Jesus.

New Testament

JESUS APPEARS TO THE 11

Luke 24: 36-49

After his Resurrection, Jesus appeared to the eleven Apostles as they were listening to disciples who told them about seeing Jesus. There were the women who went to the tomb, and there were also the two disciples who saw Jesus on the road to Emmaus and later ate with him. Suddenly Jesus was right in the same room! He said "Peace to You." Even after the stories they had heard, they thought they were seeing a ghost. Jesus showed them his hands and feet with the scars where the nails had been. He asked them to touch him and see that he had real skin and bones. He even ate a piece of fish in front of them to prove that he wasn't a ghost. Jesus told them that the Resurrection had been told in advance by the prophets. He commanded them to stay in Jerusalem waiting for the Holy Spirit.

MY FAITH

Jesus Gave us the Seven Sacraments

We see all 7 sacraments in Jesus' life. **BAPTISM & CONFIRMATION**—Jesus was baptized by John in the Jordan River. The Holy Spirit appeared in the form of a dove after Jesus' Baptism. *(Mark 1: 9-11)*

EUCCHARIST—The Last Supper was the First Eucharist, the Sacrament of the Body and Blood of the Lord *(Luke 22: 14-20)*

RECONCILIATION—Jesus forgave the people who crucified him. *(Luke 23: 31-34)*

ANOINTING OF THE SICK—Jesus healed a woman who couldn't stand up straight. *(Luke 13: 10-13)*

MATRIMONY—Jesus changed water into wine at the wedding in Cana *(John 2: 1-12)*

HOLY ORDERS—Jesus sent the Apostles out all the world. *(Matthew 28: 16-20)*
