(adapted from <u>Companion to the Calendar</u> by Mary Ellen Hynes)

#### **January 26—Saints Timothy and Titus**

Both of these saints received letters from St. Paul, so they have books in the Bible named after them. Timothy and Titus both traveled with Paul. Timothy was a good preacher. He became the first bishop of Ephesus, the city where St. John lived with Mary. Titus was probably from Antioch. He was a very talented peacemaker and could help people turn to the right way.

#### January 30—Mohandas Gandhi

On this day we remember a man who was Hindu, not Christian. He was from India where a caste system made some people "untouchable" for life. Gandhi dressed like these people in protest against the caste system. He lived a simple life and believed in change through non-violence, a lifestyle which is honored today

## New Testament THE DIVINE AND HUMAN JESUS John 1: 1-18

The Gospel of Matthew begins with the names of Jesus's human ancestors. The Gospel of Mark begins with the baptism of Jesus. The Gospel of Luke begins with the stories of John the Baptist and his parents Zechariah and Elizabeth, and with the story of Mary, Joseph, and baby Jesus. John's Gospel begins very differently. John tells us that Jesus is the WORD of God. He writes that Jesus the Son of God was with God from the very beginning, with God in Creation, and the true Light of the World. In his early ministry he was recognized by John the Baptist. John was baptizing people who were sorry for their sins and wanted to be part of the Kingdom of Heaven. John baptized Jesus also telling the people, "This is He of whom I said. The one who comes after me ranks ahead of me."

#### **MY FAITH**

### Sacraments of Initiation

Jesus shares his life with us by three special sacraments that get us started in the life of the Church and in the Kingdom of God. The first is Baptism. Catholics are usually baptized as babies, but they can be baptized at any age. Baptism is God's way of forgiving our tendency to sin and bringing us into God's family. The 2nd sacrament of initiation for adults is Confirmation. Eucharist comes 3rd for adults, but for children the Eucharist is 2nd, and Confirmation later on. Confirmation opens up the many gifts of the Holy Spirit that were given to us in Baptism. The **Bishop comes to the** church to confirm. The Eucharist, Holy Communion, is the gift of Jesus's own **Body and Blood. We** become part of the **Body of Christ.**


