SAINTS THIS WEEK

February 11—Our Lady of Lourdes

On February 11, 1858, 14-year-old Bernadette Soubirous was gathering wood at a small cave near Lourdes in southern France. Suddenly she saw “a girl in white, no taller than I, and beautiful.” The beautiful lady appeared to her 18 times. When Bernadette asked who she was, Mary said, “I am the Immaculate Conception.”

February 14—St. Valentine

There may have been 2 Valentines who were saints. Both of them died around the year 269. One may have been the bishop of Terni, Italy. In those days Christians had to meet secretly. The other Valentine was a priest and medical doctor. In the Middle Ages people believed that on February 14, the day St. Valentine died, birds began choosing their mates and humans fell in love.

New Testament

JESUS COMES TO JERUSALEM

John 2: 13—3: 21

When Jesus entered Jerusalem for the first time—according to John—he went straight to the Temple and turned over the tables of the money changers because they were more concerned with making money than with offering prayers to God.

Some people were angry with Jesus. They asked him for a sign, and he said, “Destroy this temple and in three days I will raise it up.” He was actually talking about the Temple of his Body.

Nicodemus was a ruler of the temple who came to Jesus by night.

When talking to Nicodemus Jesus explained about God’s love in this famous Bible verse—John 3: 16.

“For God so loved the world that he gave his only Son, so that everyone who believes in him might not perish but might have eternal life.”

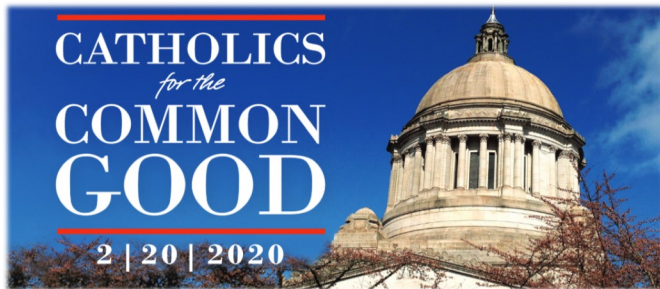
