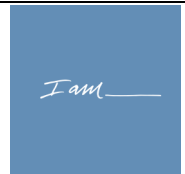
Next Saturday, March 7

SAINTS THIS WEEK

*(adapted from [Companion to the Calendar: A Guide to the Saints and Mysteries of the Christian Calendar](#)

March 1—David, Patron saint of Wales (520-589)

David was a man who wanted to live a simple life of prayer. He was a hermit living alone, eating only bread and water and vegetables that grew wild. When people heard of David’s holy way of life, they came to him for guidance and many joined him. More than a dozen monasteries were founded. David was a wonderful teacher and he became a bishop.

March 3—St. Katharine Drexel (1858-1955)

Katharine grew up in a wealthy Philadelphia family. Her parents always helped poor families to pay their monthly rent. On a trip to Rome, Katharine begged Pope Leo XIII to send missionaries to the native Americans she had seen in her travels. The Pope answered, “My child, why don’t you become a missionary yourself?” And she did, dedicating her life to serving native Americans and black Americans.

New Testament THE BREAD OF THE MIRACLE AND THE BREAD OF LIFE John chapter 6

Whenever Jesus blessed the people with a physical miracle, it always had a deeper meaning. And so it was with the feeding of the 5,000 families. The people had traveled with Jesus for a long distance and they were getting hungry. Philip was a good organizer. He could guess how much it would cost to feed these people even one meal. But a little boy got the miracle going by sharing what he had with Jesus. All the people were fed and twelve baskets were left over. After that miracle, people wanted more bread to eat, but he told them about the Bread from Heaven, his own body. Some disciples were offended by his words and stopped following him. But Simon Peter said, “Master, to whom shall we go? You have the words of eternal life.”

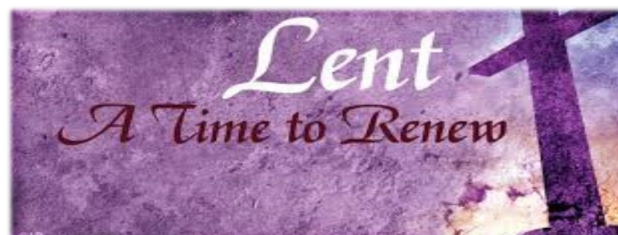
