SAINTS THIS WEEK

March 24—Archbishop Romero of El Salvador (1917-1980)

El Salvador is a small country near Mexico. During the 1980’s there was a lot of violence and poverty in El Salvador. The Archbishop Oscar Romero, decided at age 13 that he wanted to be a priest. He worked as a priest and was later called to be the Archbishop. He felt strongly that the poor people of his country were suffering from injustice and he began to speak out against the government. He was killed while saying Mass.

March 25—The Annunciation

March 25 in the Middle Ages used to be the Spring Equinox and December 25, 9 months later, used to be the Winter Solstice. The first chapter of Luke tells us that after the Angel Gabriel had come to Zechariah who was to be John the Baptist’s father, he next went to the Blessed Virgin Mary to tell her that she had been chosen to be the Mother of Our Lord. “Hail Mary, Full of Grace,” were his words.

New Testament

JESUS IN JERUSALEM

John chapter 7

Many times Jesus said to people who had been healed, “Do not talk about this to anyone.” (Matthew 8: 4) Many times the demons he had cast out shouted out his name—“I know who you are, The Holy One of God.” (Mark 1: 24) But the time came when it was the will of God that Jesus should go to Jerusalem and show himself to the people and to the temple rulers. It was the Feast of Tabernacles when he decided to show up in Jerusalem in secret, but soon started teaching in the Temple. Many people were trying to find out if he was the Messiah. He openly said that the religious rulers were trying to kill him. They even sent out soldiers to arrest him, but “his time had not yet come.” (John 7:30) He told the people that those who believed in him would receive “rivers of living water.” (John 7: 38)

MY FAITH

Made in the Image of God

If I look straight into a mirror I see myself, but not the way others see me. My image in the mirror is actually reversed. We are made in the image of God. When we look at ourselves as God sees us we see all our problems and fortunately we see how much God loves us. SPIRITUAL ADOPTION UPDATE "I'M DANCING"

The baby is making rapid progress developing all her external and internal organs. During the second month baby teeth form and her fingers and toes are developing. Ears, nose, lips and tongue can now be clearly seen. The taste buds are forming. The baby responds to touch. If the baby's nose is tickled, she will flex her head backward away from the stimulus. The mother will not feel movement until the fourth or fifth month because the inside of the uterus has no feeling. The baby has to be almost a foot long and weigh about one pound before he or she is large enough to brace a shoulder against one wall and kick hard enough against the opposite wall to dent it outward. Then the mother feels it. The baby can hiccup, make a fist, wake & sleep. The skeleton changes from cartilage to true bone. The central nervous system is now functioning 100,000 nerve cells are created every minute. Brain waves can be recorded by an EEG during this month. Forty muscle sets begin their first exercises. By 8 weeks old body systems are present and the baby is called a "fetus", a Latin word meaning "little one" or "young one". Ultrasound reveals that this little one can now spring & jump-her first dance steps. "Your hands have formed me and fashioned me. With skin and flesh you clothed me, with bones and sinews knit me together." (Job 10: 8-11). Please continue to pray for these little ones.
