

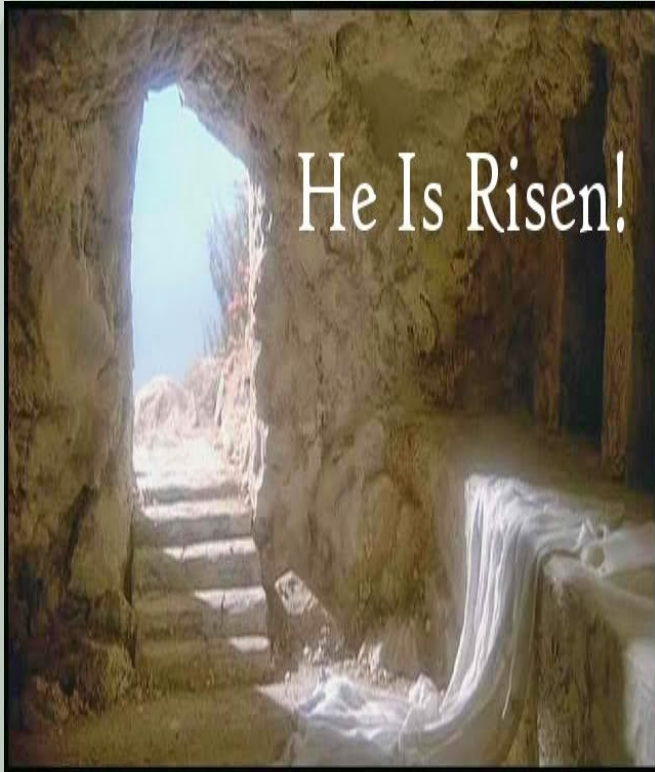

MY FAITH

Human Freedom and Conscience

Every day we have decisions to make. Shall we get up and help the family or stay in bed until someone gets mad? Shall we say hello to the new person at school or wait to see if he or she is popular? Shall we take that piece of candy that was on the wrong shelf at the store, or leave it alone? Shall we play with little sister or leave her to her own toys? Our conscience helps us with these decisions. What is the best thing to do? What would make Jesus smile? How would we want to be treated? Every day our conscience grows strong as we spend time with Jesus.

April —EASTER

Easter is the day when Jesus rose from the dead, bringing eternal life to all of us. How do we know that Jesus brings us eternal life through his Resurrection?

First of all, the Creed teaches that he really did die on the cross. Many people saw him die.

When he is seen alive again and talks to many people at different times, that shows that he is alive.

Is Jesus exactly like before? No. Thomas can see the nail scars from the crucifixion. Also Jesus looks different. People don't recognize him at first.

Jesus proves that he is not a ghost by eating, even by cooking breakfast for his friends at the seaside.

Jesus told us that he goes to prepare a place for us so that where he is we can be also. Then a cloud received him! That means that we will see him again after we die. **JESUS IS ALIVE!**

New Testament

“LAZARUS, COME OUT!”

John chapter 11

Jesus had three special friends named Martha, Mary, and Lazarus, a brother and 2 sisters living in Bethany. Jesus often went to see them. “Mary was the one who had anointed the Lord with perfumed oil and dried his feet with her hair.” (John 11: 2) When Lazarus became ill Martha sent word to Jesus that he should come right away. But instead Jesus delayed for 2 days. It was dangerous for Jesus to return to the village of Bethany, so close to Jerusalem. But that is not why Jesus delayed. God had in mind a miracle even greater than a healing. Jesus reached the grave and commanded for Lazarus to come out of the grave. He came out bound in his grave clothes, having been dead for 4 days! The Resurrection of Lazarus gives us yet another reason to hope for life with Jesus in Heaven.
