April 23—St. George and the Princess

George was a martyr who may have been a soldier in the Roman army. He died around 303. There is a famous story about George. A town was terrorized by a dragon who wanted the people of the town to feed him animals for his meals. When they ran out of meat, he wanted to eat their children! A beautiful Princess (she represents the Church) offered to give herself as the dragon’s meal. George fought with the dragon and killed it. In many of the stories the dragon comes back to life and has changed into a very friendly dragon who can be led around by the Princess, a ribbon around his neck.

April 25—Saint Mark

Mark wrote the Gospel according to Mark. He traveled with St. Paul and St. Barnabas in their missionary journeys.

“THE GREAT SERMON

John chapter 14-17

St. John in his gospel is the only one to record the words of Jesus at the Last Supper. These are the main things that Jesus told us before he went to the Sorrowful Cross and the Glorious Resurrection.
