THIS WEEK

(From Companion to the Calendar: A Guide to the Saints & Mysteries of the Christian Calendar by Mary Ellen Hynes)

April 29—St. Catherine of Siena

Catherine was a woman who lived only to the age of 33. She spent all of those years helping her family and helping the poor. She was the 23rd child in her family. Early in life she decided not to get married, and instead to live in her parents' home and do the work of a servant. She had trouble learning to read, but she was very wise. Catherine was called a "doctor of the church" because she helped people solve quarrels and think about difficult questions. At one point the Pope was living in France. But Catherine convinced him to come back to Rome.

April 30—Saint Pius V

St. Pius V (the Fifth) had a difficult job because he was the Pope who had to make sure that the Church followed the reforms they had set out to do after the Council of Trent. It is because of St. Pius that priests are given a good education and taught to lead simple lives.

New Testament

PETER'S DENIAL

John chapter 15: 15-27

Sometimes it's easy to say that we will follow Jesus. Peter told Jesus that he was willing to die with him and he would follow right to the death. However, when given the chance to say he knew Jesus personally he just froze up and said "I do not know him."

Maybe Peter was thinking that he would be arrested at the same time as Jesus and they would face their trial together. But sometimes there are things that Jesus needs to do alone, and then he teaches us how to follow.

Peter wasn't prepared for ordinary people to ask him, "Aren't you one of them?" After he had denied Jesus three times, the rooster crowed, and he realized that he was unable to keep his promise. Later in life, with the help of the Holy Spirit, Peter did claim Jesus as his Lord and Savior. He did die a martyr's death in Rome.

MY FAITH

Cardinal Virtues

A virtue is a habit that helps us to follow God. The Cardinal Virtues are prudence, fortitude, temperance and justice. You can remember these by pointing.
Point to your head. Prudence is the habit of making the right decision, especially knowing the consequences of your actions. Point to your heart. Fortitude is the habit of getting rid of things that keep you from doing what is right. It is also called courage. Point to your tummy. Temperance is the habit of not taking too much of a good thing such as food or fun. Point upward. Justice. Point outward and up and tell them about Justice – the virtue (habit) of giving others, including God, what is due to them.

SPIRITUAL ADOPTION UPDATE-THIRD MONTH

“I CAN SUCK MY THUMB NOW!”

In January many of our parishioners spiritually adopted newly conceived babies, making a commitment to pray daily as they grow and develop. Those babies are now twelve weeks old. Their feet are perfectly shaped. Eyelids, fingernails & toenails form and he now has his own set of fingerprints. Their entire body is sensitive to touch and can feel pain. He will tightly grasp an object placed in the palm of his hand. They sleep and wake regularly. Vigorous activity shows distinct individuality. The babies can kick, turn their feet, make fists, move their thumbs, bend their wrists, turn their heads, open their mouths and press their lips together. They “breathe” amniotic fluid to help develop their respiratory systems. He can now squint, swallow and move his tongue. In fact, early this month - around week 9 - he began to suck his thumb. All pretty amazing for one so small. Please remember to pray daily for these little ones!
