

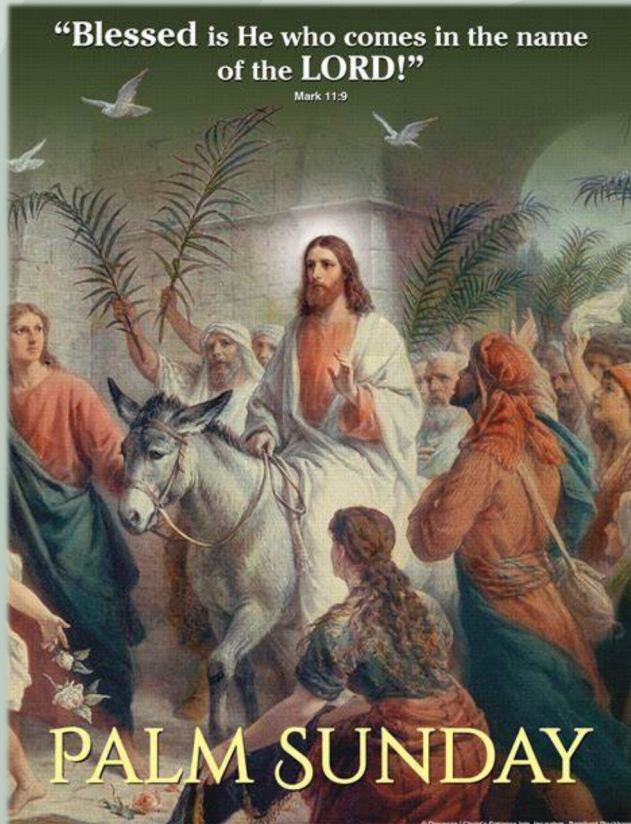

THIS WEEK

April 5—PALM SUNDAY

Palm Sunday is the day when Jesus rode into Jerusalem on a donkey—the custom of ancient kings—the same week as his trial and crucifixion. Worshipers carry blessed palm leaves or a substitute. Around the world there are many different customs. Here in Seattle it feels strange not to go to Mass because of the Corona virus situation. In other countries sometimes they cannot have their typical celebrations because of wars. But no matter what is happening around us, the celebration of Palm Sunday is always a joyful time because Jesus brings us into the Kingdom of God.

Marigolds are placed in the altar of Eastern Orthodox churches in India when ‘Hosanna’ is called out in recognition of Jesus’ arrival in Jerusalem. According to legend, St. Thomas the Apostle brought Christianity to India in 52 CE. The Philippines reenact Jesus entering Jerusalem in the form of a priest on a horse. Worshipers with palm leaves parade alongside him. Pieces of material are often placed along the path by the women. Afterwards, people attach the fronds on their doors and windows to receive Jesus and repel evil spirits.

New Testament

THE MAN BORN BLIND

John chapter 9

The Man Born Blind is one of the longest stories in the Bible. Another long story is found in Genesis chapter 24, when Abraham sends his servant to find a wife for his son Isaac. Jesus was in Jerusalem. He passed by a man who had been blind all his life. His disciples wanted to know whether he had sinned or if his parents had sinned. Jesus said that he was born this way “so that the works of God might be made visible through him.” (John 9: 3) The temple rulers were very upset with Jesus for healing on the Sabbath. They questioned the man, others who knew him, and even his parents trying to find out what happened and if they could accuse Jesus of doing wrong. Some people just can’t see what is right in front of them! Pray for people who cannot see, that Jesus will put clay on their eyes to heal them.
