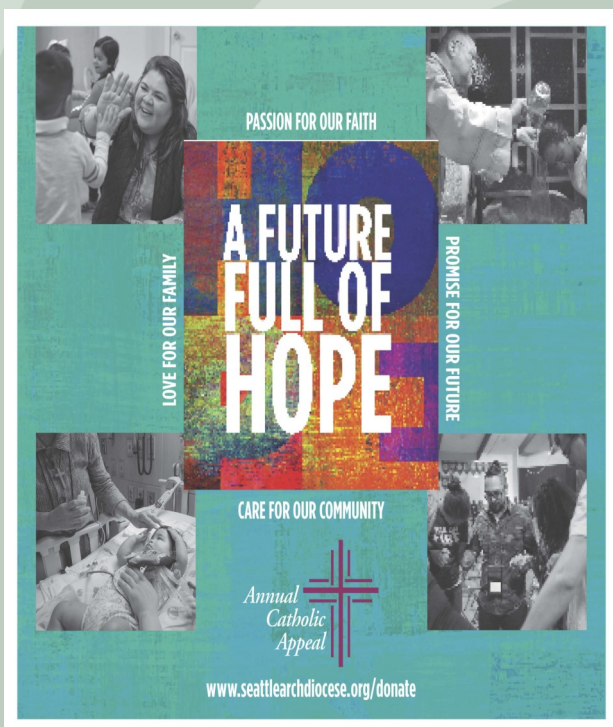

Ellen Hynes)*

May 21—Jane Addams (1860-1935)

Jane Addams is not in the Catholic Calendar of Saints, but we can all learn from her love of God and her dedication to the poor people of Chicago.

Jane was fortunate to spend time in Europe as a young girl where she learned several languages.

Knowing several languages helped her to communicate with the many foreigners who were pouring into the United States at the end of the 1800's.

She rented a large house in Chicago that she called Hull House. Jane started daycares, helped working mothers, taught sewing classes, and worked to eliminate dangerous child labor.

New Testament

THE ACTS OF THE APOSTLES

Acts 1: 1-14

When Luke wrote his first book—the Gospel of Luke—he also wrote a second book—The Acts of the Apostles. Both these books were dedicated to someone named “Theophilus.” In Greek that name means a person who loves God. Luke wanted everyone to know about Jesus.

The book starts with the promise from Jesus that the faithful would receive the Holy Spirit. He said to them that they would be “baptized with the Holy Spirit.” Some disciples thought Jesus would restore the Kingdom of David here on earth, but God had other plans. Instead Jesus ascended into heaven, with a cloud taking him out of their sight. After that they devoted themselves to prayer while waiting for the Holy Spirit.

We know the 10 Commandments and we work hard to follow them in our own lives. When we fail to do what is right and we know we are doing wrong, this is called sin. Sometimes a whole group of people in a city or country follow each other into doing something that is wrong. This is called social sin. A sad example of social sin was that the United States allowed slavery to be legal from the very first day of the new country. Lots of countries allowed slavery, and many of our people followed in that wrong path. It is also social sin when we don't feed the hungry, visit prisoners, and welcome newcomers.

SPIRITUAL ADOPTION UPDATE-FOURTH MONTH

"I Had A Dream Today"

The baby's brain has begun maturing- a process that will continue until about 14 years old. Their feet are perfectly shaped; eyelids, nails & fingerprints are fully formed. Their entire body is sensitive to touch and they can feel pain. Their taste buds are now forming. Nutrients consumed by the mother are passed on to her baby within an hour or two. Three hundred liters of fluid a day are sent to the baby via the umbilical cord. Fine hair begins to grow on the baby's head. Facial expressions similar to the baby's parents can be seen at this time. The baby sleeps & wakes regularly; swims freely & can turn somersaults. Vigorous activity shows distinct personalities. The baby can kick, turn his feet, make fists, move his thumbs & turn his head. The baby's ears are developing and there is evidence that they can hear certain sounds—mom's voice & heartbeat & some internal noises. This month REMS {rapid eye movements} have been recorded- a sign of dreaming. Please continue to pray for babies in danger of abortion.


