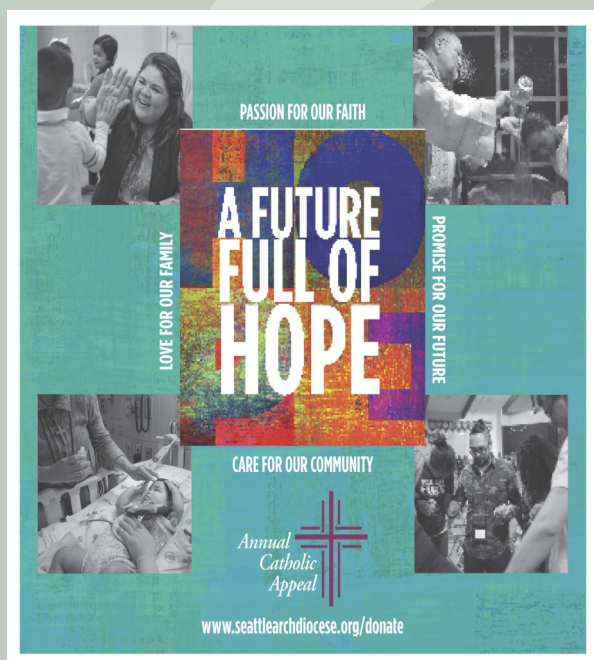

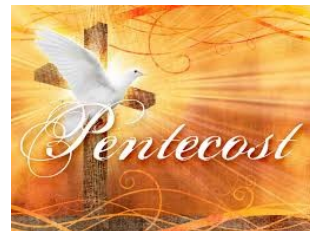

Memorial Day

Memorial Day is a Commemoration of the Day when World War II came to an end in Europe. Many of the people who served in that war have died. We go to their gravesites with fresh flowers to thank our ancestors for keeping us in their hearts during the times that they lived through.

May 30—Joan of Arc (1412-1431)

Joan of Arc was a warrior saint. She led the French armies against the English and won six major battles, making it possible for Charles to be crowned King of France. Charles did not show any appreciation for her leadership. When the English captured Joan, Charles did nothing to save her. She was unjustly tried and martyred at the age of 19.

New Testament

MATTHIAS IS CHOSEN

Acts 1: 15-26

When Jesus chose his 12 disciples he must have known that one of them—Peter—would become the head of the Church, and that one of them—Judas Iscariot—would betray him to the Roman soldiers.

After Judas identified Jesus in the Garden of Gethsemane, he soon realized that Jesus was not going to do a miracle to get himself away, and that he was going to die as an innocent man. The truth of what he had done was too much for Judas and he killed himself.

Peter led the Apostles in choosing a replacement for Judas, one who had followed Jesus during his earthly ministry. The choice was between Justus Barsabbas and Matthias. They drew lots (like drawing straws) and chose Matthias.

SPIRITUAL ADOPTION UPDATE-FOURTH MONTH

"I Had A Dream Today"

The baby's brain has begun maturing- a process that will continue until about 14 years old. Their feet are perfectly shaped; eyelids, nails & fingerprints are fully formed. Their entire body is sensitive to touch and they can feel pain. Their taste buds are now forming. Nutrients consumed by the mother are passed on to her baby within an hour or two. Three hundred liters of fluid a day are sent to the baby via the umbilical cord. Fine hair begins to grow on the baby's head. Facial expressions similar to the baby's parents can be seen at this time. The baby sleeps & wakes regularly; swims freely & can turn somersaults. Vigorous activity shows distinct personalities. The baby can kick, turn his feet, make fists, move his thumbs & turn his head. The baby's ears are developing and there is evidence that they can hear certain sounds—mom's voice & heartbeat & some internal noises. This month REMS {rapid eye movements} have been recorded-a sign of dreaming. Please continue to pray for babies in danger of abortion.
