The Feast of the Visitation—May 31

When Mary received the news from the Archangel Gabriel (Annunciation March 25) that she would be the Mother of the Messiah, the first thing she did was to run to the house of her cousin Elizabeth, who was pregnant in her old age, mother of John the Baptist. Mary stayed with her about three months until the baby was born. The 2nd Joyful Mystery of the Rosary tells the story of this Visitation, which you can also read about in Luke 1: 39-56. As soon as Elizabeth heard the sound of Mary’s voice, the unborn baby (John the Baptist) “leaped in her womb.” How we would love to hear the sound of Mary’s voice. That will be one of the treasures waiting for us in Heaven.

New Testament

PENTECOST

Acts 2: 1-41

We remember three great miracles from Pentecost. The disciples and others were all gathered in one place when suddenly the first miracle occurred. A sound like a “strong driving wind” filled the house. The second miracle was fire. Separate flames of fire appeared above each of their heads. The third miracle was that they could suddenly speak in different languages they had never learned. The Holy Spirit had given all three of these gifts.

How do we know that we have been visited by the Holy Spirit? The Presence of the Holy Spirit can be in a cloud (the Ascension), a flame (the Burning Bush), a dove (the Baptism of Our Lord), or even a clear beautiful thought. Listen for the Holy Spirit in your life.

SPIRITUAL ADOPTION UPDATE-FOURTH MONTH

“I Had A Dream Today”

The baby’s brain has begun maturing—a process that will continue until about 14 years old. Their feet are perfectly shaped; eyelids, nails & fingerprints are fully formed. Their entire body is sensitive to touch and they can feel pain. Their taste buds are now forming. Nutrients consumed by the mother are passed on to her baby within an hour or two. Three hundred liters of fluid a day are sent to the baby via the umbilical cord. Fine hair begins to grow on the baby’s head. Facial expressions similar to the baby’s parents can be seen at this time. The baby sleeps & wakes regularly; swims freely & can turn somersaults. Vigorous activity shows distinct personalities. The baby can kick, turn his feet, make fists, move his thumbs & turn his head. The baby’s ears are developing and there is evidence that they can hear certain sounds—mom’s voice & heartbeat & some internal noises. This month REMS {rapid eye movements} have been recorded—a sign of dreaming. Please continue to pray for babies in danger of abortion.
