May 2—St. Athanasius

Athanasius was born in Egypt in 295 AD. He had a really good education and as a young adult spent time in the desert learning from St. Anthony who was a powerful man of prayer.

We mostly remember Athanasius because he spoke out against a false teaching (from a priest named Arius) that Jesus was a human being who was NOT divine, and had become the son of God only after proving himself to be worthy. This false teaching was believed by many Christians.

Athanasius helped to write the Nicene Creed which clearly states that Jesus is "God from God, Light from Light, true God from true God, begotten not made, consubstantial with the Father."

As a bishop for 50 years, he often suffered from persecution, but he was humble and kind.

New Testament

JESUS'S LAST SUPPER PRAYER

John chapter 14-17

Even knowing that he was facing death, Jesus spent the Last Supper letting his disciples know that they would never be alone. Here are some quotations from his famous prayer.

"Do not let your hearts be troubled. You have faith in God. Have faith also in me."

"Believe me that I am in the Father, and the Father is in me."

"If you love me, you will keep my commandments."

"The Holy Spirit that the Father will send in my name—He will teach you everything and remind you of all that I told you."

"I am the Vine. You are the branches."

"Now this is eternal life, that they should know You, the only true God, and the one whom you sent, Jesus Christ."

Theological Virtues

A virtue is a habit that helps us to follow God. The Theological Virtues are Faith, Hope, and Charity (Love). St. Paul wrote, "So faith, hope, and love remain, but the greatest of these is love."

FAITH is the virtue which helps us believe in God and all that he has said and revealed to us,

HOPE means that we desire the kingdom of heaven and eternal life as our happiness, placing our trust in Christ's promises.

LOVE. We are taught to love God above all things for his own sake, and to love our neighbor as ourselves.

SPIRITUAL ADOPTION UPDATE-THIRD MONTH

“I CAN SUCK MY THUMB NOW!”

In January many of our parishioners spiritually adopted newly conceived babies, making a commitment to pray daily as they grow and develop. Those babies are now twelve weeks old. Their feet are perfectly shaped. Eyelids, fingernails & toe-nails form and he now has his own set of fingerprints. Their entire body is sensi-
tive to touch and can feel pain. He will tightly grasp an object placed in the palm of his hand. They sleep and wake regularly. Vigorous activity shows distinct indi-
viduality. The babies can kick, turn their feet, make fists, move their thumbs, bend their wrists, turn their heads, open their mouths and press their lips togeth-
er. They “breathe” amniotic fluid to help develop their respiratory systems. He can now squint, swallow and move his tongue. In fact, early this month - around week 9 - he began to suck his thumb. All pretty amazing for one so small. Please remember to pray daily for these little ones!
