SPIRITUAL ADOPTION UPDATE-FIFTH MONTH "Mommy felt me kick today!"

Our spiritually adopted babies, who we have been praying for, are now five months old and the wonderful miracles of God's creation and life are so evident. This month marks the half-way point to birth, and the baby is very active. Sleep habits develop and his mother can feel him move and stretch, particularly when she is resting. He is twelve inches now and big and strong enough to kick hard against the outside uterine wall and dent it. The baby's ears are fully formed and they respond to sound. They are able to hear their mothers' heartbeat and voice. Many moms begin to sing to their babies at this stage.
