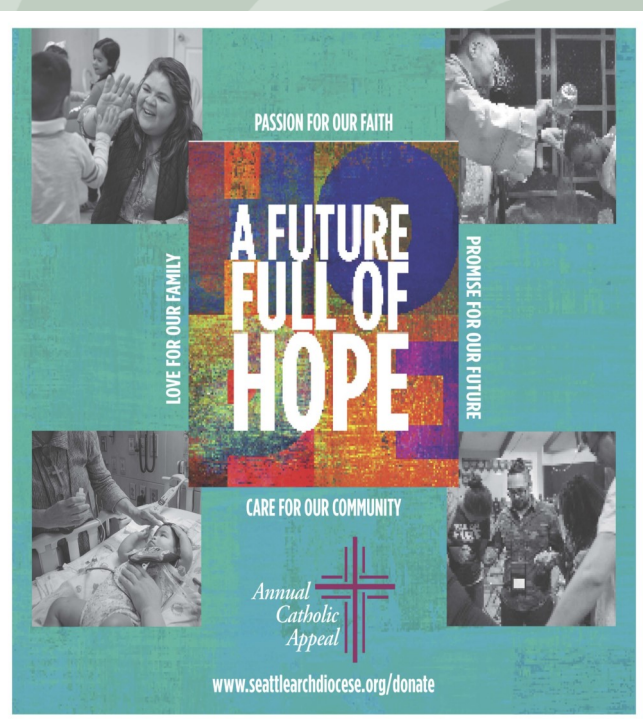

Saint Anthony of Padua—June 13
(1195-1231)

These days we are facing new situations because of the pandemic. What a good time for a saint whose whole life was full of surprises. He wanted to be a missionary to Morocco in North Africa. As soon as he arrived he became very ill and had to go back to his home country of Portugal. But as soon as he got on the ship a terrible storm blew the ship off course and he ended up in Italy. The surprises weren't over. St. Francis was still alive and Anthony got to meet him. Anthony was a wonderful preacher. When people wouldn't listen to him he would preach to the fish in the sea. Anthony is the patron saint of lost items. "Tony, Tony! Please come round. Something's lost that can't be found."

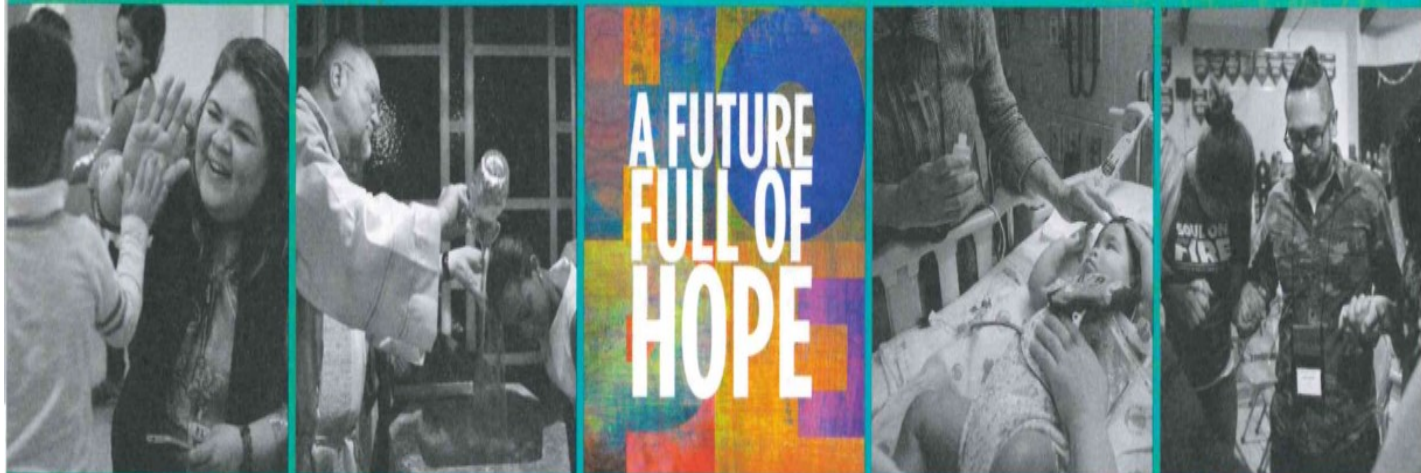

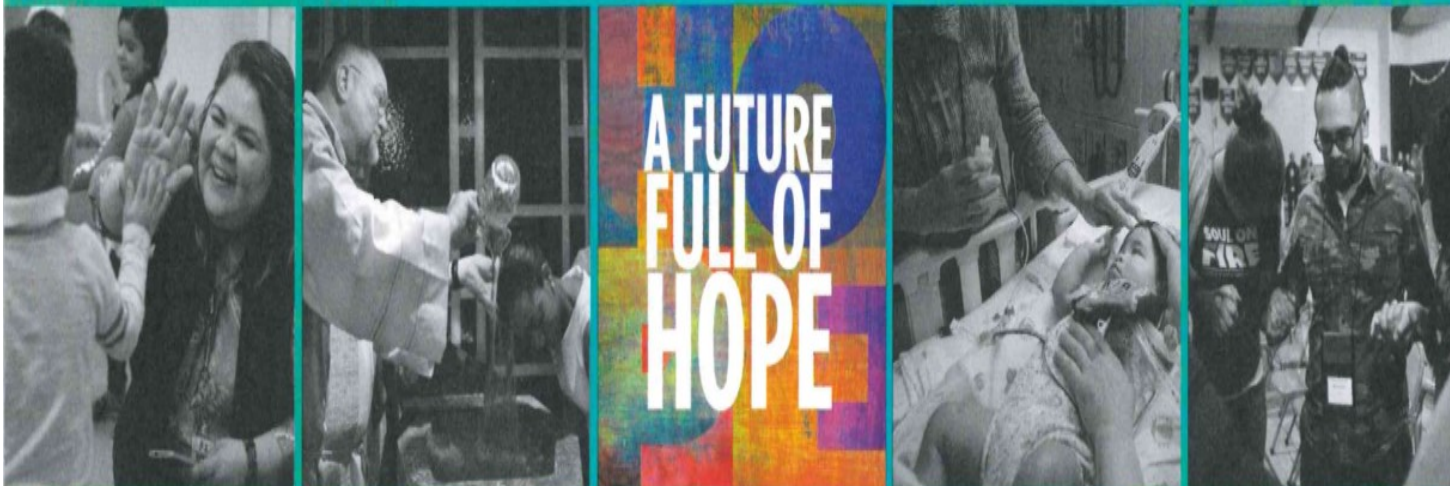
