### This Week's Feast Day The Transfiguration of the Lord

*(From Companion to the Calendar: A Guide to the Saints & Mysteries of the Christian Calendar by Mary Ellen Hynes)*

Peter, James, and John were led by Jesus up to a high mountain. They were amazed and frightened when the face of Jesus shone as bright as the sun. Moses and Elijah appeared on the mountain with Jesus. The three of them talked about Jesus' coming death and resurrection.

The cloud of the Holy Spirit surrounded them. And the voice of God proclaimed, "This is my beloved Son with whom I am well pleased. Listen to Him."

After Jesus was raised from the dead, the three disciples remembered what had happened that day.

### New Testament Saul is Baptized and Starts Preaching ACTS chapter 9

## SPIRITUAL ADOPTION UPDATE—SIXTH MONTH

"I'm Sitting Up Straight Now!"

During the sixth month of life, our spiritually adopted pre-born babies will grow to  
14 inches and increase in weight to almost 2 pounds. The baby's oil glands and  
sweat glands are functioning; these help regulate body temperature. A white filmy  
layer covers the baby and protects their delicate skin from the surrounding  
amniotic fluid and from scratches as she twists and turns. This waxy substance, a  
sort of natural skin cream, will be quickly absorbed into her skin soon after the  
baby is born. During the fifth and sixth month of life, the pre-born baby develops a  
very firm handgrip. It is even more powerful than that of an infant soon after birth.  
The baby can now respond to sound. The baby's lungs are fairly well developed,  
and would stand a good chance of survival if born at this time.
