This Week's Saints Our Lady of Mount Carmel

(From Companion to the Calendar: A Guide to the Saints & Mysteries of the Christian Calendar by Mary Ellen Hynes)

Mount Carmel was a holy place hundreds of years before Christ was born. It was there that the prophet Elijah called for a contest with the prophets of the pagan god Baal. The power of God was shown when God caused a soaking wet altar to burst into flame and burn the offering. In early Christian years, people who went to pray settled on the mountain, and a monastery was built there. In 1251 the leader of the Carmelites. Simon Stock, had a vision of Mary the Mother of God. July 16 became a special feast for the Carmelites, and in the 1700's the feast was celebrated by the entire Church, especially in Italy, where people parade through the streets carrying a statue of Mary.

THE FIRST DEACONS AND THE FIRST MARTYR

ACTS chapter 6

In the Catholic Church, a deacon is a man who reads the Gospel during the Mass, sometimes preaches the sermon, and is the Ordinary Minister of the Blood of Christ. That means that if a deacon is present, he is always the one to hold the Cup. Also a deacon helps us to know how to care for the poor. In the early Church 7 deacons were chosen to help with serving the families so that the Apostles

could devote all their time to preaching and spreading the good news about Jesus rising from the dead.

The first martyr who was killed for preaching about Jesus was Stephen. When he died he saw a vision of heaven opening.
