This Week's Saints Saint James

(From Companion to the Calendar: A Guide to the Saints & Mysteries of the Christian Calendar by Mary Ellen Hynes)

In Spain Saint James is known as Santiago. There is a famous shrine in his honor at a place called Compostela. For centuries and even now pilgrims walk along the road to Compostela, wearing in their hats a shell to remind them that Saint James (the brother of John) was once a fisherman. James and his brother were among the first disciples called by Jesus. They left their father Zebedee to follow Jesus. Later on we meet their mother, who somehow knew that her sons would be great men in the Kingdom of God. Many times Jesus brought Peter, James, and John along with him for a special event such as the Transfiguration. James led the Church in Jerusalem.

New Testament

THE ADVENTURES OF PHILIP

ACTS chapter 8

Philip was from Bethsaida in Galilee. the same town as brothers Andrew and Peter. He became a follower of Jesus and told others about him, telling Nathanael, "We have found the one Moses wrote about." (John 1: 44) When 5,000 people were hungry, Jesus asked Philip about feeding them. (John 6: 5) Later on some Greeks came to Philip wanting to meet Jesus. (John 12: 21) So we know that Philip loved to tell people about Jesus. In Samaria, after Pentecost, Philip was preaching, healing people, and casting out demons. Then the Holy Spirit sent him on the road to Gaza, where he met a man who was studying the prophet Isaiah and wondering who the prophet was talking about. Here was another chance to tell someone about Jesus.

Personal Prayer and Shared Prayer

One of the reasons we memorize certain prayers is that we might not know what to say to God if we haven't prayed before. But prayer is really very simple. Did you ever call loudly for someone and find out they are in the same room? God is always with us. You can start a prayer by saying, "Thank you for being here. I have something I need to talk about." You can go to the **Blessed Sacrament** and listen to see if Jesus wants to say something straight to your heart. It is also very special to pray with people in your family. Many parents listen to their children's night time prayers. **Prayer reminds us** God is always here.

SPIRITUAL ADOPTION UPDATE—SIXTH MONTH

"I'm Sitting Up Straight Now!"

During the sixth month of life, our spiritually adopted pre-born babies will grow to 14 inches and increase in weight to almost 2 pounds. The baby's oil glands and sweat glands are functioning; these help regulate body temperature. A white filmy layer covers the baby and protects their delicate skin from the surrounding amniotic fluid and from scratches as she twists and turns. This waxy substance, a sort of natural skin cream, will be quickly absorbed into her skin soon after the baby is born. During the fifth and sixth month of life, the pre-born baby develops a very firm handgrip. It is even more powerful than that of an infant soon after birth. The baby can now respond to sound. The baby's lungs are fairly well developed, and would stand a good chance of survival if born at this time.
