### This Week's Saints Saints Ann and Joachim

*(From Companion to the Calendar: A Guide to the Saints & Mysteries of the Christian Calendar by Mary Ellen Hynes)*

When we say "Virgin Birth," we are talking about the birth of Jesus as his mother Mary conceived by the Holy Spirit. Her husband Joseph took care of Mary and Jesus. God is the Father of Jesus, as we learn in the creed.

Unlike her son Jesus, Mary did have two human parents and their names were Ann and Joachim. Of course they are known to be saints because of the love and care they showed to God by raising Mary (who was conceived without sin—the "Immaculate Conception") and loving their grandson Jesus. Many people in Europe celebrate July 26, the feast day of saints Ann and Joachim, as a special day for grandparents.

### New Testament THE CONVERSION OF PAUL ACTS chapter 9

If you wanted to look for the one person who caused the most trouble for the early Church, you would want to look at Paul. He did everything in his power to stop the new Christian religion, called THE WAY. Paul's life shows us that God has plans for us, and the sooner we agree with God's plans, the happier we will be. Paul (his Hebrew name is Saul) was on the way to Damascus with letters from the Temple in Jerusalem to arrest men and women who worshiped Jesus the Christ. These people were being jailed and in some cases, killed.

"A light from the sky suddenly flashed around him. He fell to the ground and heard a voice saying to him, 'Saul, Saul, why are you persecuting me?'" The voice was Jesus. Paul's new life had begun.

### MY FAITH

#### Prayer by Singing and Meditating

I grew up in a singing family. We didn't have a car radio, so we sang whenever we were in the car. My parents were musicians and they were good at singing harmony. Back in those days I had a high voice and I always wanted to sing the top part. My sister Thalia sang the alto part, and the little sisters just sang along however they could. We especially liked songs about Jesus. Besides singing, you can pray by meditating. We Catholics love to meditate in front of the Blessed Sacrament. Some people spend an hour or more in the presence of Jesus. That is called a Holy Hour. But if you don't have that much time, try to spend a Holy Minute with Jesus.

## SPIRITUAL ADOPTION UPDATE—SIXTH MONTH

"I'm Sitting Up Straight Now!"

During the sixth month of life, our spiritually adopted pre-born babies will grow to  
14 inches and increase in weight to almost 2 pounds. The baby's oil glands and  
sweat glands are functioning; these help regulate body temperature. A white filmy  
layer covers the baby and protects their delicate skin from the surrounding  
amniotic fluid and from scratches as she twists and turns. This waxy substance, a  
sort of natural skin cream, will be quickly absorbed into her skin soon after the  
baby is born. During the fifth and sixth month of life, the pre-born baby develops a  
very firm handgrip. It is even more powerful than that of an infant soon after birth.  
The baby can now respond to sound. The baby's lungs are fairly well developed,  
and would stand a good chance of survival if born at this time.
