### This Week's Saints Benedict and Scholastica

*(From Companion to the Calendar: A Guide to the Saints & Mysteries of the Christian Calendar by Mary Ellen Hynes)*

Saint Benedict and his sister are very famous. Benedict is the Patron Saint of Europe. When Benedict first heard God's call to prayer, he became a hermit. That is someone who lives alone far from other people. But plenty of people came to him and asked to follow his simple way of life. Benedict founded a monastery called Monte Cassino in Italy where men would live together in order to work and pray. He had a motto "ora et Labora" which means "Pray and Work." His sister St. Scholastica founded a similar community for women. Everyone worked and no one kept personal belongings. Every visitor who came to a Benedictine House was treated as if Christ himself had come to visit.

### New Testament

#### LIFE IN THE CHRISTIAN COMMUNITY

#### ACTS chapter 4

The healing of the beggar who could not walk was the beginning of a dramatic story for the early Christians. The man who received the miracle was very happy, but the rulers of the Temple were not happy. They ordered Peter to stop talking about the Resurrection of Christ. They kept Peter and John in jail overnight. The next day they questioned them about who had given them authority to do miracles. They ordered the disciples not to talk about Jesus. But Peter and John disobeyed this order, being full of the Holy Spirit and filled with Joy that Jesus had conquered death for us. The Christians lived together and shared all they had.

#### Corporal Works of Mercy

**Corporal Works of Mercy are things that you can do for the body of a person. Spiritual Works of Mercy are things that God can lead you to do for someone's soul.**

- Instruct the ignorant. (Teach about Jesus.)

- Admonish the sinners. (Speak up if you see wrongdoing.)
- Bear patiently those who wrong us. (Stay calm when someone hurts your feelings.)
- Forgive offenses. (Forgive those who hurt you.)

- Pray for the living and the dead.
