This Week's Saints Benedict and Scholastica

(From Companion to the Calendar: A Guide to the Saints & Mysteries of the Christian Calendar by Mary Ellen Hynes)

Saint Benedict and his sister are very famous. Benedict is the Patron Saint of Europe. When Benedict first heard God's call to prayer, he became a hermit. That is someone who lives alone far from other people. But plenty of people came to him and asked to follow his simple way of life. Benedict founded a monastery called Monte Cassino in Italy where men would live together in order to work and pray. He had a motto "ora et Labora" which means "Pray and Work." His sister St. Scholastica founded a similar community for women. Everyone worked and no one kept personal belongings. Every visitor who came to a Benedictine House was treated as if Christ himself had come to visit.

The healing of the beggar who could not walk was the beginning of a dramatic story for the early Christians. The man who received the miracle was very happy, but the rulers of the Temple were not happy. They ordered Peter to stop talking about the Resurrection of Christ. • Counsel the doubtful. (Share your faith.)


• Admonish the sinners. (Speak up if you see wrongdo-ing.)
