This Week's Feast Day August 21 Saint Pope Pius 10th

(From Companion to the Calendar: A Guide to the Saints & Mysteries of the Christian Calendar by Mary Ellen Hynes)

Pius X (Roman numeral for 10) lived from 1835 to 1914, a son in a large family. His father was a postman. It was unusual for a poor person to become a bishop, but Giuseppe Sarto (his baptismal name) was such a good preacher and pastor, that the Church needed his talents.

As pope, he acted on his belief that

As pope, he acted on his belief that children should be allowed to have Communion at Mass as soon as they were able to understand. We can thank Pope Pius X for our large classes every year of children preparing for First Communion.

The first World War began in 1914. He predicted world wide suffering.

New Testament Actions of the Early Church ACTS chapter 11

So much was happening in the early Church that Luke (the author) must have talked to a lot of people to get it all set down in writing. In those days writing was done on parchment. The parchments would be copied and copies sent by travelers to the different churches.

Once it became clear that Gentiles (not Jewish) were becoming Christian, the people in Jerusalem had decisions to make about whether Gentile Christians and Jewish Christians would worship together and worship the same way. These conversations led to large meetings called councils. After Deacon Stephen was killed, Christians began to move to other cities. They brought the Good News with them to their new homes.

What Can Children Do for Jesus?

- 1. Help with the Mass. Children can be altar servers as soon as they receive their first Communion.
- 2. Help at home. Parents do the best they can to provide food and shelter and a happy life. A cheerful child can make everyone smile.
- 3. Be kind. Even if you are shy, you can be kind. Ask someone what their name is. Invite younger brothers and sisters to play a game with you.
- 4. Pray every day. When you wake up dedicate your day to the joy of being God's child. Before you go to sleep, name all the people you want God to bless.
- 5. Try not to compare yourself with other people. We all have our talents. God made you just the way He wants you to be.



SPIRITUAL ADOPTION UPDATE—SIXTH MONTH

"I'm Sitting Up Straight Now!"

During the sixth month of life, our spiritually adopted pre-born babies will grow to 14 inches and increase in weight to almost 2 pounds. The baby's oil glands and sweat glands are functioning; these help regulate body temperature. A white filmy layer covers the baby and protects their delicate skin from the surrounding amniotic fluid and from scratches as she twists and turns. This waxy substance, a sort of natural skin cream, will be quickly absorbed into her skin soon after the baby is born. During the fifth and sixth month of life, the pre-born baby develops a very firm handgrip. It is even more powerful than that of an infant soon after birth. The baby can now respond to sound. The baby's lungs are fairly well developed, and would stand a good chance of survival if born at this time.


