This Week's Feast Day

August 25

Saint Louis of France

*(From Companion to the Calendar:
A Guide to the Saints & Mysteries of
the Christian Calendar by Mary
Ellen Hynes)*

You don't often meet a king who is also a saint. Kings have a lot of wealth. Sometimes they are spoiled and selfish. But King Louis of France was just the opposite. He started to rule the country when he was very young—only 12 years old.

He loved God and loved his Christian faith. Louis spent hours every day in prayer. He was married to Queen Marguerite and together they had ten children. He fed the poor from his own table, sometimes waiting on them himself. He provided homes for widows and orphans. Louis was fair and just, and refused gifts. He would sit under an oak tree to listen to people's stories and their requests.

New Testament

Paul's First Missionary Journey

ACTS chapters 13 and 14

The Good News about Jesus rising from the dead was for all the world. It wasn't long before missionaries were traveling throughout the Roman Empire to start and encourage new Christian communities. Paul and Barnabas were partners on Paul's first missionary journey. They went to Cyprus, Antioch, Iconium, Lystra, and Pamphylia.

They sailed to Cyprus and talked to the governor who believed their message. Back out to sea, their young companion John Mark left them, which caused some trouble later on. Paul would go to the synagogues—Jewish places of worship—and teach that the prophets told about Jesus long before he came to earth. They also spoke to Gentiles, and healed people wherever they went.

What Happens during the Mass?

If you are used to videos and video games, you might be surprised that the Mass seems to be a lot of talking. But the talking is only part of the story.

During the Corona Virus time, the Mass has changed so that people won't be too close together. We wear masks and keep our distance.

You don't see them, but every time the Mass is offered we are surrounded by angels from heaven who never get tired of telling the story of Jesus's love for us. Listen to the words and you will hear the entire story of salvation history—how God created us to be good, how he came into the world and suffered and died, and how he is with us all the time and forever.

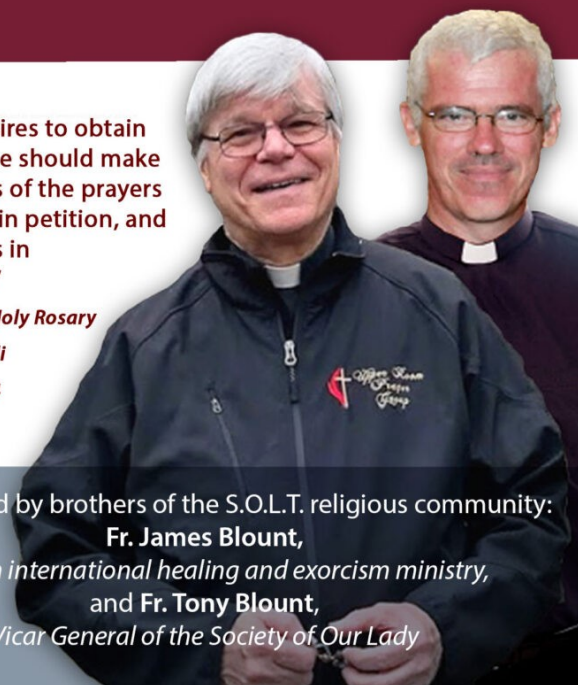
