This Week's Feast Day September 1 Saint Ruth

(From Companion to the Calendar: A Guide to the Saints & Mysteries of the Christian Calendar by Mary Ellen Hynes)

Our friends from the Old Testaments are saints, even though they were born before Jesus. They loved God and followed the teaching of God's prophets and priests.

Ruth was from a nearby country called Moab. During a time of famine when there was no food, Naomi's family moved from Bethlehem to Moab. Naomi's sons married Moabite women including Ruth. When Naomi's husband and her two sons died, she decided to return to Bethlehem.

Ruth would not be parted from her mother in law. She worked hard in the fields to feed both of them, and eventually she married a rich farmer named Boaz. They had a son named Obed, who was the father of Jesse and the grandfather of King David.

Favorite Parts of the Bible

The Bible is full of wonderful stories if you know where to look. If you open the Bible at random, you might find long lists of names. But if you focus on the stories of the great people, you will always go back to these stories again and again and the people will become your lifelong friends.

Genesis has some of the greatest passages: the Creation, Noah and the Ark, Abraham and his family, Joseph who was sold as a slave to Egypt and ended up ruling the country!

Exodus tells the story of Moses. Ruth has her own book of the Bible. That is also true for Jonah which is only three pages long. All four Gospels tell about Jesus's life on earth, from the day that Mary was given the gift of mother-hood until he died and rose again and ascended into Heaven.


