This Week's Feast Day August 11—St. Clare

*(From Companion to the Calendar:
A Guide to the Saints & Mysteries of
the Christian Calendar by
Mary Ellen Hynes)*

When St. Francis of Assisi began his way of following Jesus, he gained many followers. His way was unusual because his followers didn't build houses to live in. They lived among the people and helped them with their daily lives. Clare was an 18 year old girl who wanted this kind of life.

Living in a palace, she longed to simply follow Jesus. She gave up her rich clothes and fancy jewelry. Clare started a group called the Poor Ladies. She became the servant of the other women, waiting on them at the table and caring for them when they were sick. The Poor Ladies never owned property. They are now called the Poor Clare's.

New Testament Cornelius and Peter ACTS chapter 10

Try to imagine what it would be like if all your life you were not allowed to eat dinner with people who were not like you. That was the case with the Apostle Peter. Since Jesus's first disciples were Jewish, Peter naturally thought that only Jews would understand God's message of salvation and eternal life.

God sent Peter a vision. A tablecloth was lowered down, containing foods that he had never eaten, as they were called "unclean"—foods like pork and shrimp. When God told him to eat these things, it was a message that was not just about food.

A non-Jewish (gentile) man called Cornelius received a vision at the same time telling him to go meet Peter. The two men became great friends, working together to teach that Jesus died for all the world.

MY FAITH Praying the Our Father

Our Father who art in heaven, hallowed be Thy name. Thy kingdom come, Thy will be done on earth as it is in heaven. Give us this day our daily bread, and forgive us our trespasses as we forgive those who trespass against us. And lead us not into temptation but deliver us from evil.

Part of this wonderful prayer is in old-fashioned English. So many people know it by heart that the words have stayed the same for hundreds of years. Art means are. Hallowed means holy. Thy means Your. Trespasses means sins. Lead us not into temptation means help us to avoid wrong actions.

SPIRITUAL ADOPTION UPDATE—SIXTH MONTH

"I'm Sitting Up Straight Now!"

During the sixth month of life, our spiritually adopted pre-born babies will grow to
14 inches and increase in weight to almost 2 pounds. The baby's oil glands and
sweat glands are functioning; these help regulate body temperature. A white filmy
layer covers the baby and protects their delicate skin from the surrounding
amniotic fluid and from scratches as she twists and turns. This waxy substance, a
sort of natural skin cream, will be quickly absorbed into her skin soon after the
baby is born. During the fifth and sixth month of life, the pre-born baby develops a
very firm handgrip. It is even more powerful than that of an infant soon after birth.
The baby can now respond to sound. The baby's lungs are fairly well developed,
and would stand a good chance of survival if born at this time.
