In the last two months the baby continues to gain weight. Her skin will soon begin to thicken, smooth out and become pink. Wrinkles disappear as the baby gains fat deposits which store nourishment and provide insulation to keep her warm after she is born. Antibodies build up to start to protect against a wide range of illnesses. With a normal weight of five pounds, the baby fits snuggly within the womb. Towards the end of the eighth month, it will only be possible for the baby to turn from side to side-no more summersaults. The baby will now most likely settle into a head-down position, preparing for birth. Her lungs are now fully developed and capable of making the transition to breathing air. 
