## Children & Family Ministry

#### Jesus called the disciples to pick up their cross and follow him.

He calls us to follow him too, even when times are hard. No matter how bad the situation, God can use it to help us grow.



September brings the start of a new school year, which usually means connecting with friends, meeting new teachers and getting brand new school supplies. Now, with the pandemic, most of us will begin the school year at home with remote instruction. Parents and children alike are disappointed and concerned about what this fall will bring.

Though they pale in comparison, our disappointments give us a sense of how the disciples must have felt upon learning Jesus' destiny to die on the cross in our Gospel reading. Sometimes, we have to make sense of the reality that God's plan for us includes things we don't want.

### **Talk**

Here are some reflection questions to help you have **Great Conversations** with the whole family.



Four things we can do to help our children grow this fall:

- Start by reflecting on your feelings about the fall to come. How do you feel about a fall with remote instruction? Are you disappointed or worried?
- Relate an experience when God was at work in a difficult
  experience in your past. Let your children know about a time when
  you truly experienced disappointment and/or difficulty. How did it
  feel at the time? Looking back on the experience, can you see how
  God was at work, now that you have more perspective?
- Ask your children how they feel about starting school with remote instruction. If they are experiencing disappointment, let them share those feelings.
- Encourage your children to pray, asking God to help them.
   Encourage them to pray not just that the difficulties of the fall will be eased, but that God will strengthen them with courage and self-control so that they might grow in strength and maturity during this time.


