



**Anxiety is part of the human experience.** Uncomfortable as it may be, anxiety offers us a challenge and an opportunity to train our minds to seek God first in all things.



In 2019, The Pew Research Center reported anxiety as the <u>number one concern for teens in the United States</u>. Though anxiety is on the rise today, it's not a new concern. This week's reading from St. Paul's letter to the Philippians demonstrates that anxiety is part of the human condition.

St. Paul teaches that in moments of anxiety we can choose to focus on "whatever is true...honorable...just...gracious [or] worthy of praise" - those things that make us aware of God's presence. As parents, we do our children a great service if we help them face their anxieties through the perspective of faith. In doing so, we are teaching them to fix their eyes on Jesus during moments of fear and adversity.

Numbers to share about Next Step Pregnancy Services for the period March 2020—August 2020:
- ⇒ About 1,350 clients during those months—giving out boxes of diapers, wipes and formula.
- ⇒ About 500 of clients were repeat or regular clients, others were newcomers mostly due to unemployment.
- ⇒ Performed about 106 pregnancy testes—about 40 of these were abortion vulnerable women
- ⇒ Performed about 45 ultrasounds
