This week on FORMED

There is a video The 12 Day of Christmas: <https://watch.formed.org/carousel/videos/12-days-of-christmas>. It is only about 6 minutes and explains what the 12 days of Christmas really are. The Archdiocese of Seattle on their Facebook and Instagram pages is also doing a series of what the items in the song "The Twelve Days of Christmas" represents. We won't make you wait though:

- The partridge in a pear tree was Christ
- The two turtle doves were the Old and New Testaments
- The three French hens stood for faith, hope, and love.
- The four calling birds were the four gospels of Matthew, Mark, Luke, and John.
- The five golden rings represented the first five books of the Old Testament, which describe man's fall into sin and the great love of God in sending a Savior.
- The six geese a-laying stood for the six days of creation.
- Seven swans a-swimming represented the sevenfold gifts of the Holy Spirit—Prophecy, Serving, Teaching, Exhortation, Contribution, Leadership, and Mercy.
- The eight maids a-milking were the eight beatitudes.
- Nine ladies dancing were the nine fruits of the Holy Spirit—Charity, Joy, Peace, Patience [Forbearance], Goodness [Kindness], Mildness, Fidelity, Modesty, Continency [Chastity].
- The ten lords a-leaping were the Ten Commandments.
- The eleven pipers piping stood for the eleven faithful Apostles.
- The twelve drummers drumming symbolized the twelve points of belief in The Apostles' Creed.

What are you doing for 2021? In the Northwest Catholic that just came out there several things that fellow Catholics are going to do for their faith in 2021. Check it out! To access FORMED go to <https://formed.org/> Click on Sign Up. Next choose the middle button; *Sign Up as a Parishioner*; Type in St. Brendan and then click on St. Brendan 10051 NE 195th St Bothell WA. Then you register with your name and email. There is no payment since the parish has a subscription.
