#### **MALAWI UPDATE**

Please keep our brothers and sisters in prayer as COVID 19 is on the rise again. Namalaka has intensified their preventive measures once again. Schools have been closed for 3 weeks and many of our friends have lost their source of income again. The rains have started to fall in Malawi, and we pray for a good growing season for all. We are helping Namalaka with two projects. We are able to do this due to our parishioners continued generosity in supporting our sister parish. We are going to help to fund the building of a fence around the rectory. This is primarily for security purposes. This will allow for gated access to the priest's house, which is guite common in Malawi. We also are going to help with the construction of a cook's house on the rectory property. This will allow the cook to be much closer to Fr, Davie and when the heavy rains come and the roads flood, he will have access to work. The parishioners of Namalaka have already molded the brick needed for both projects which is a large part of the projects. We will be helping fund the gates for the fence, windows and a tin roof for the house and other materials. A BIG thanks to those of you who have donated to our sister parish!
