CONSECRATION TO ST. JOSEPH

Pope Francis has announced that this year (from December 8, 2020 to December 8, 2021) will be the Year of St. Joseph. Please continue to keep our sisters and brother in prayer. We have two positive cases of COVID 19. The catechist Luciano Sam and the Pastoral Council chair, Dismas Makilika. Our parish has met both of them several times. Both are isolating and we are praying for their recovery. Keep in mind our sister parish is pretty remote so many people will not have access to testing, so we pray for everyone whom may be impacted. Schools are still currently closed in Malawi, which means also that the feeding program is on hold. The rains have started to fall in Malawi, and we pray for a good growing season for all.
