ST. BRENDAN GARDENS

March is when we'll begin again our monthly garden work parties to beautify our grounds, though in March we'll have two work parties to get ready for Easter: **Saturday, March 6 and Saturday, March 27.** Feel free to join us on one or both of these mornings. One of the projects will be to clean up along the gravel path on the east side of the church building, add new stones and mulch and plan more ferns alongside the path. If you have any small sword ferns from your yard that you'd like to donate, we would appreciate it and could use them. In fact, as you start working in your gardens and need to divide plants or just dig up new seedlings, please think about potting them up for a fundraising plant sale in April. Any questions? SOS—A few highlights from 2020:

- We had 25 volunteers in the day-old groceries Gleanings & hot meals initiative of the SOS Program. Seven are Knights from Bothell Council 6686. (Note: Many other people volunteer for SOS in other capacities. Larry Pomada is the program manager).
- On-site hot meal preparation and cooking was cancelled ca. February 2020 when COVID-19 began to spread throughout Washington State.
- A temporary agreement was struck to continue SOS operations, via the Northshore Senior Center Kitchen preparing ~120 hot meals each week, to be transported to St. Brendan for the Thursday SOS meal and distribution to the following area homeless camps:
 - New Bethlehem Project (Kirkland/Redmond)
 - The Landing (Kirkland)
 - New Ground (now Youth Haven) (Kirkland)
 - Camp Unity (Transient - mostly Woodinville)
- On May 21 we began recording the Gleanings food weight and value, as well as volunteer hours and miles. (This was first suggested by Glenn Podany.)
- May 21 - December 2020, we collected 36,117 lbs. of food (value over \$55,000). We logged 1,183 hours and 5,757 miles, collecting food from PCC Bothell and the Holy Innocents Food Bank, and distributing hot prepared meals to the above homeless shelters.

It was a sad week in Namalaka, Their catechist, Luciano Sam, the person who has been the constant presence since we first established our sister parish relationship passed away this past week from COVID 19. We are deeply saddened by his loss and join our prayers with our sisters and brothers in praying for his soul and for his wife, 8 children and parish family. Dismas Makilika continues to recover from COVID 19. Keep in mind our sister parish is pretty remote so many people will not have access to testing, so we pray for everyone whom may be impacted. Schools are still currently closed in Malawi, which means also that the feeding program is on hold. The rains have started to fall in Malawi and we pray for a good growing season for all. School may resume on Monday, February 8th, but we are currently waiting for the government to make that decision.
