SUNDAY, JUNE 2-SOLEMNITY OF THE MOST HOLY

On June 2, Sunday, on the Solemnity of the Most Holy Body and Blood of Christ (Corpus Christi), immediately after the Noon Mass, join us for a Eucharistic Procession through downtown Bothell.

WHAT IS 40 HOURS' DEVOTION?

Forty Hours' Devotion is a special exposition of the Blessed Sacrament over a period of three days, during which prayers continues uninterrupted for an approximate total of 40 hours. It begins and ends with a solemn Mass, and there is a Eucharistic procession and benediction at the end of the final Mass.

The 40 hours is similar to a parish renewal or retreat, but with more time for mental and personal prayer It is a time to be alone in prayer with Jesus.

The number 40 and period of three days is a remembrance of the 40 hours from Jesus' burial until His resurrection, but also a remembrance of the 40 days fast of Jesus in the desert.

Join us at 7:30AM in the chapel followed by 8:30AM Mass. This is our second month Novena. Let us ask Our Lady's intercession for conversion and peace throughout the world. According to St. Pio, the Rosary is the most powerful weapon to defeat the devil. In Fatima, Our Lady said if people will not stop offending God, there will be 2nd World war and it did happen. We can help prevent chastisement by praying the Rosary every day and do the Saturday devotion.

Spiritual Adoption Update: Three Months - "I'm three inches!" "I can suck my thumb now!" The baby now sleeps and awakens. Fingernails and toenails form and he has his own unique set of fingerprints. Sensitive to touch, he will tightly grasp an object placed in the palm of his hand. He breaths amniotic fluid to help develop and strengthen the respiratory system, but he gets the oxygen he needs through the umbilical cord. He can now squint, swallow and move his tongue. In fact, early this month - around week 9 - he began to suck his thumb.


