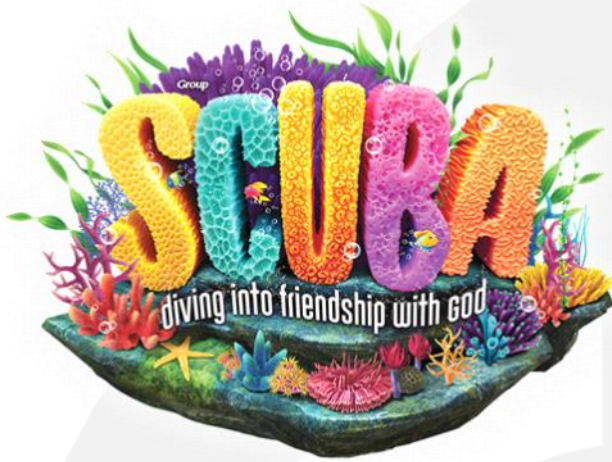
A BLESSED FATHER'S DAY

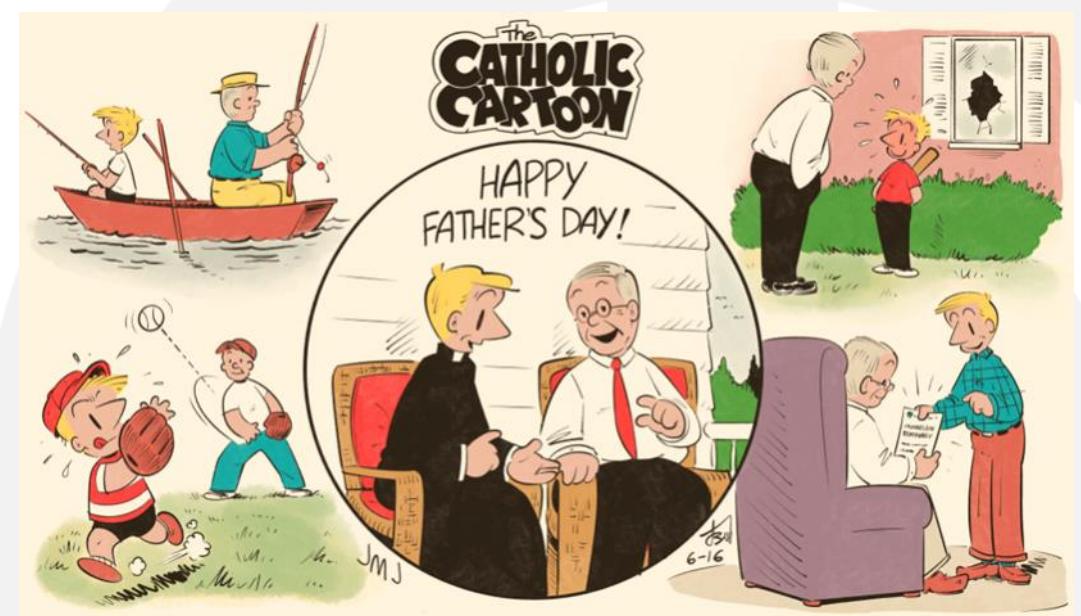
