BAPTISM PREPARATION—Do you have a child under 7 who has not been Baptized? We'd like to encourage and help you with that process. If you wish to have a Baptism in the coming months, it is never to early to start the planning with the Church. In addition to other requirements, the Church requires all Parents and God Parents of children under 7 attend a Baptism Prep Class.

Those classes are given in both Spanish and English, but are only given once a month. **Baptism Prep Classes are typically given on the first Saturday of the month, the next one is Saturday, Feb. 1st after the 8:30AM Mass**. The next Baptism is planned for Sunday February 23rd at 1:30PM. **Please contact Mark Sizemore in the Parish Office as soon as possible if you are planning a Baptism in the coming months**.

ONLINE PARISHIONER STEWARDSHIP PLEDGES/ONLINE GIVING

Every person's finances and family situation is different. Jesus makes it clear that it matters not how much one gives, but that it is planned, calculated, at least some-what sacrificial (see Luke 24:1-4), and not simply from what is "leftover" at the end of the month.

We propose the tithe(10%) as the ideal every family can consider working towards. This means taking steps to give 5%to one's parish and 5% to other charities, or causes you have personal passion for.
