

BAPTISM PREPARATION—**Do you have a child under 7 who has not been Baptized?** We'd like to encourage and help you with that process. If you wish to have a Baptism in the coming months, it is never to early to start the planning with the Church. In addition to other requirements, the Church requires all Parents and God Parents of children under 7 attend a Baptism Prep Class.

Those classes are given in both Spanish and English, but are only given once a month. Baptism Prep Classes are typically given on the first Saturday of the month, the next one is Saturday, Feb. 1st after the 8:30AM Mass. The next Baptism is planned for Sunday February 23rd at 1:30PM. Please contact Mark Sizemore in the Parish Office as soon as possible if you are planning a Baptism in the coming months.

PREPARACIÓN PARA EL BAUTISMO—¿Tiene un niño menor de 7 años que no ha sido bautizado? Nos gustaría animarle y ayudarle con ese proceso. 

SPIRITUAL ADOPTION PROGRAM

This weekend our Respect Life Ministries will have a table in the Narthex in which you will be given the opportunity to spiritually adopt a baby who is in danger of abortion. It involves praying a simple prayer daily for nine months by the late Archbishop Fulton J. Sheen. Prayer cards are available in English and Spanish. This program helps us all act upon our church's teaching that all life is wanted and sacred. The Spiritual Adoption of Unborn Children has three goals:

1) To encourage parishioners to pray daily over nine months for unborn children and women facing a crisis pregnancy and considering an abortion. 2) To educate parishioners about the development of their "adopted" unborn child through announcements describing fetal development. The beautiful poster will be displayed in the kiosk in the Narthex each month. 3) To celebrate the birth of the "adopted children" with a baby shower at the end of nine months. The gifts will be given to local mothers in need.

This program was developed by the Pro-Life Office of the Diocese of Camden, N.J. and included in the Respect Life Month materials produced by the National Conference of Catholic Eris pro and U.S. Catholic Conference in 1990-1991. We hope to have many parishioners join this program to save God's unborn children.
