The incredible year of 2024 into January 2025 has netted over \$350,000. This is thanks to long-term donors in Catholic parishes and *Water From Wine* non-profit partner in turning wine into water.

Water Access Now began at St. John Vianney in 2011 with Catholic Relief Services (CRS) in Ghana as our implementing partner on the ground. Our volunteer board has voted to branch out with a pilot program in Uganda this year. Every person's finances and family situation is different. Jesus makes it clear that it matters not how much one gives, but that it is planned, calculated, at least somewhat sacrificial (see Luke 24:1-4), and not simply from what is "leftover" at the end of the month.

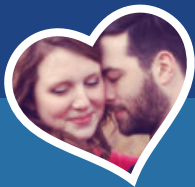
