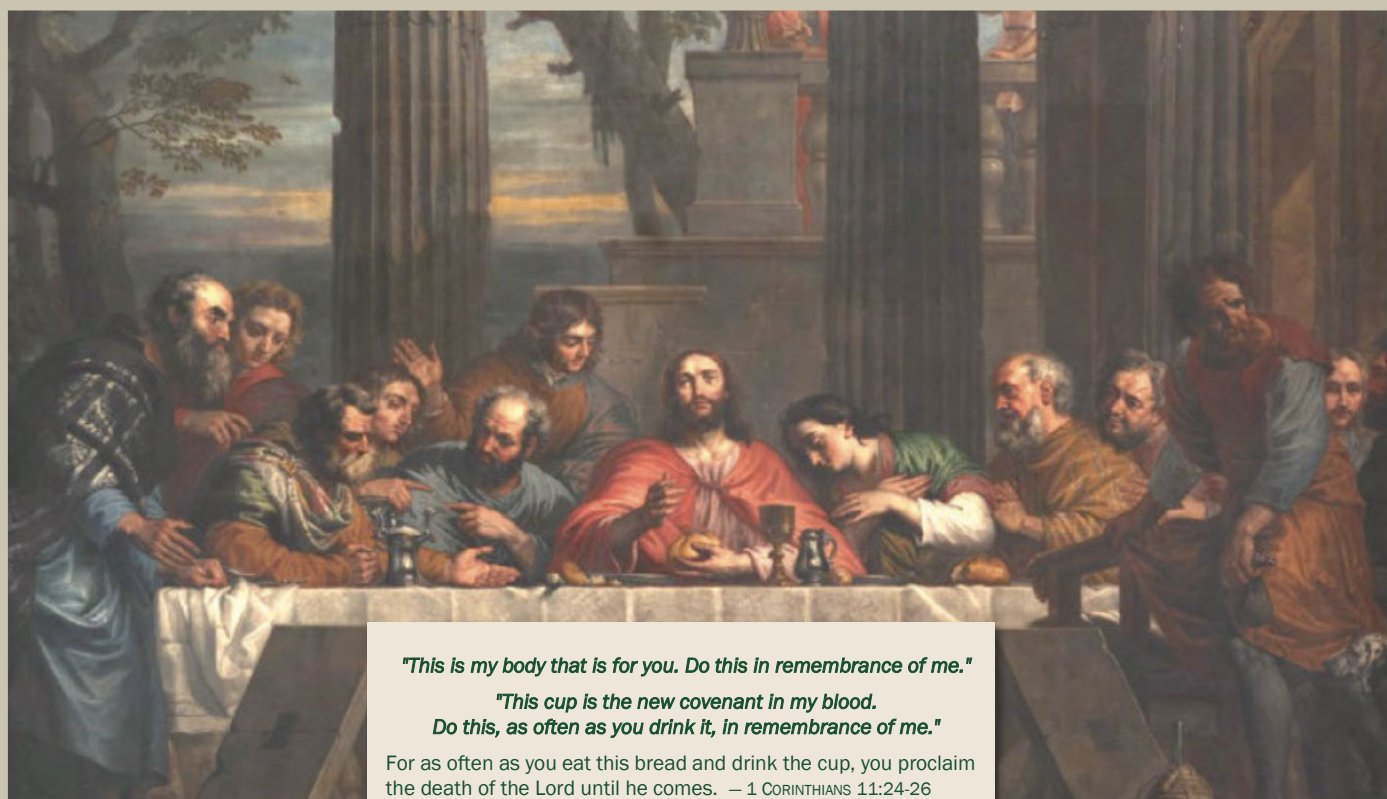

Grant us refreshment of mind and body.

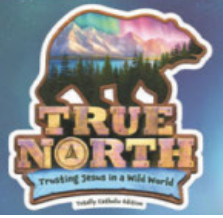

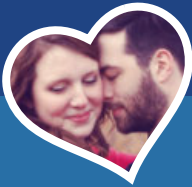
